The Landmark, Hanoi, Vietnam Architect in a project that was to include commercial and office areas, as well as underground stores over a total area of 460,000 sq.m. The project was planned in 2006, but was never executed.

Mega Mall Ruse, Bulgaria

Architect in a project that included a mall, cinema complex and hypermarket over an area of 56,000 sq.m. Was completed in 2009.

VABank, Kiev, Ukraine

A 20 storey office building with underground parking over a total area of 34,000 sq.m. The project was planned in 2007, but was never executed.

Delta City Mall, Belgrade, Serbia

Project architect in a project that included a 40 storey office building, hotel, congress center and commercial spaces over an area of 150,000 sq.m. The project was planned in 2006, but was not executed.

Bat Yam Mall, Israel

Team leader in the overall renovation of the mall in the Tel Aviv suburb of Bat Yam. The project included an Urban Building Plan (UBP) for increased commercial rights and the addition of a retirement home and offices tower over a total area of 58,000 sq.m (including the existing building and parking structure). The UBP is for 2,500 sq.m of added commercial spaces and for the 35,000 sq.m tower.

Vita Tower, Bnei Brak, Israel

Architect in a project that includes offices, underground parking and ground-level commercial spaces over a total area of 23,500 sq.m.

The project was completed in 2013.

Ein Bokek, Dead Sea, Israel

Team leader in a project that includes a commercial center, underground parking and a UBP for increased rights and an added hotel over a total area of 10,000 sq.m.

Ljubljana Mall, Slovenia

Architect in a project that was to include a commercial center, sports center, stadium, and underground parking over a total area of 180,000 sq.m. The project was planned in 2012, but was not executed.
