Selected Projects

Teaching Military hospital of Brazzaville, Congo

Team leader – The project includes a new main building with an ER, imaging, operating facilities, Daycare facilities, inpatient departments and a VIP department. The site also included and outpatient building, a mother and child building, education center, commercial center, Hotel, sport center and staff residential building. Total project area – 55,000 sq.m. The hospital design was driven by the functionality of the hospital, creating a good clear connection between the departments and the buildings while making sure all patient and staff work in a well lit healing environment. The site topography was used to create different entrance points for guests, patients and services.

Abarbnel Mental health hospital, Bat Yam, Israel

Team Leader – The project included a new enclosed youth department and an enclosed Autistic department and a hostel within an existing mental health hospital. Total project area – 5,500 sqm. The project required conducting a deep research into the special requirement of the patient and staff.

Champion Tower, Bnei Brak, Israel

Project architect - The project is located at the developing Bnei-Brak Business Center, facing one of the largest shopping malls in Israel. Champion Tower is home to the main Audi. Volkswagen and Skoda dealerships and offices. Total project area - 100,000 sq.m. Champion Tower includes 32 office floors above five parking levels and a ground floor with retail, cafes, restaurants and the large car showrooms. Its two facades communicate with one another, one clad with glass in a geometrical white division, and the other with glass in a horizontal and vertical grey division. The two masses embrace each other, creating a dialogue between the two volumes.

Stockport Road, Manchster, England

Project architect - development of 34 apartments that included 3 buildings and Semi underground car parking.

Agden Hall Cottage, England

Project architect – conversion of an existing barn to 6 houses while retaining the existing features of the buildings.
