CU Ramat Hahayal Tel Aviv, Israel Interior design of a high-end complex that contains 4 office towers: a floor lobby, main lobby and bathrooms. Total area of 120,000 sq.m. The project was completed in 2015.

Ovnat Tower, Petah Tikva, Israel Interior design of the mixed building addition of 11 storey offices and hotel, above the parking structure adjacent to Ovnat Shopping Center. Total area 30,000 sq.m. Construction to be completed by 2016.

HaEmek Hospital – Multipurpose Building, Afula, Israel

Manhattan Tower, Tel Aviv, Israel Interior design of the public spaces of a 39 storey residential building containing 170 residential units: lobby, spa and swimming pool. Total area of 28,000 sq.m. The project was completed in 2007.

Assuta Medical Center, Ramat Hahayil Tel Aviv, Israel

Interior design of public spaces in the complex medical center, considered to be the most advanced and sophisticated in Israel. Total area of 48,000 sq.m and parking with area of 40,000 sq.m. The project was completed in 2007.

rand Mall, Varna, Bulgaria

Interior design in the construction of the mall, with a total of 150,000 sq.m. of constructed areas above ground. The complex combines a mall with commercial spaces and movie theaters. The building has an underground parking together with an exclusive residential tower. The project was completed in 2007.

Plovdiv Shopping Center, Bulgaria Interior design of the Plovdiv Mall in Bulgaria. Total of 30,000 sq.m built above ground. The building combines a shopping center with commercial uses and Movie Theater above underground parking lot and a luxury residential tower. The project was completed in 2008.

Cotroceni Park Shopping Center, Bucharest, Romania

Interior design of one of the largest shopping centers in Europe and the largest in Eastern Europe. 120,000 sq.m of commerce, 250 shops, 20 movie theaters, 5,000 sq.m of recreation area and food court. The project was completed in 2008.
